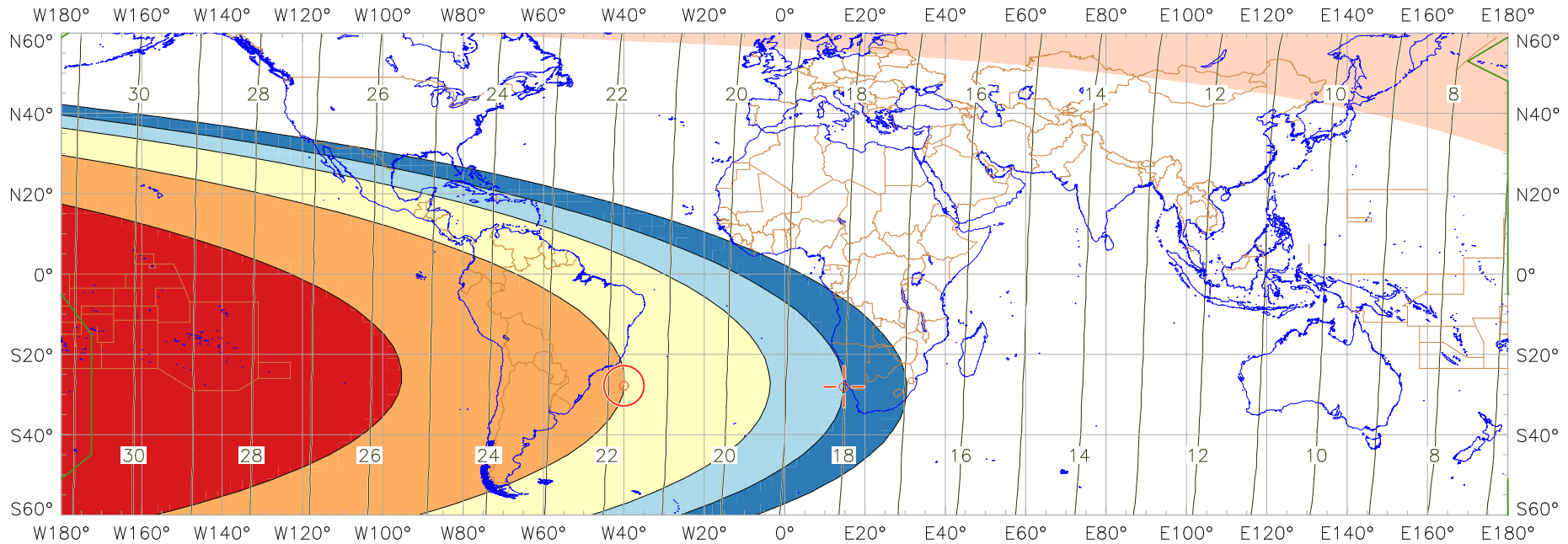


Visibility of the New Crescent Moon for 1996 September 13 (Jumada al-Ula 1417 AH)



New Moon occurred at 1996 September 12 at 23:07 UT
 Age of the Moon at first visibility with the naked eye = 21.73 hours

Age of the Moon in hours at the "Best time" ——— 20 ———
 Age of the Moon at first visibility with a telescope = 18.02 hours

New Crescent Moon Visibility Key – Colour Coding of Shaded Areas
