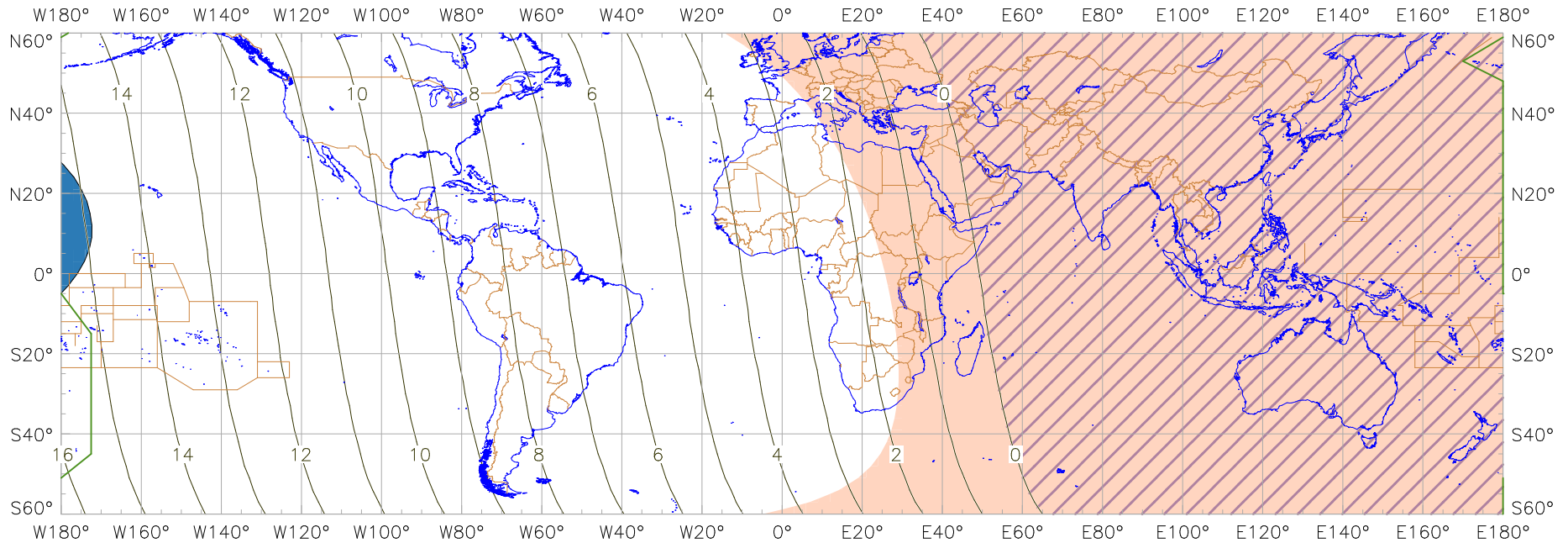


Visibility of the New Crescent Moon for 2017 February 26 (Jumada al-Ahira 1438 AH)
