

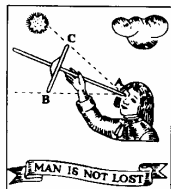

Addendum to the Astronomical & Calendrical Sheets for 2007 – 2012

St Andrew's Day Bank Holiday (Scotland)

The Royal Assent was given on the 15th January 2007 to the “St Andrew's Day Bank Holiday (Scotland) Act 2007”. This act inserted the following paragraph to Schedule 1 of the Banking and Financial Dealings Act (1971) (c.80):

“The 30th November, if it is not a Saturday or Sunday or, if it is a Saturday or Sunday, the first Monday following that day.”

The Scottish Executive has declared that the aim of this act is to promote St Andrew's Day, on November 30th, as a national celebration of Scottish identity and culture across the whole of Scotland. However, it does not automatically create an additional day off work or school; it does not oblige employers to change their existing pattern of holidays nor does it add to the total number of designated local holidays in any year.
