

## **NavPac 4.0.12 to NavPac 4.0.13 Patching instructions**

### **Information**

This Patch makes the following changes:

1. Fixes a bug that caused NavPac to go unresponsive when transferring high latitude values into certain functions.
2. Updates a constant used to calculate GHA Aries.
3. Fixes a typo in the closing warning message.

### **Before running the NavPacPatch20180508.msp file**

You will need to have the following information available during the running of this patch file.

- NavPac4 16-digit Product Key (this can be found by running NavPac 4 and clicking the “About” button)

### **Running the NavPacPatch20180508.msp file**

1. Ensure you are logged in to the machine using the same user log-in as used to install NavPac 4.0.12. (This ensures the correct user privileges are present)
2. Run the NavPacPatch20180508.msp file
  - a. If you encounter an error message, this usually means that you do not have the correct user privileges to update NavPac. In this event, please contact your system administrator and ask them to install the patch.
3. Agree to the License Agreement.
4. Enter the NavPac installation directory when asked.
5. Enter your NavPac 4 Product Key (see above on how to locate this)
6. Allow the installation to run.

### **After running the NavPacPatch20180508.msp file**

Run NavPac 4 and click the “About” button. Near the bottom of the “About” window you should see that NavPac is now running as version 4.0.13.
