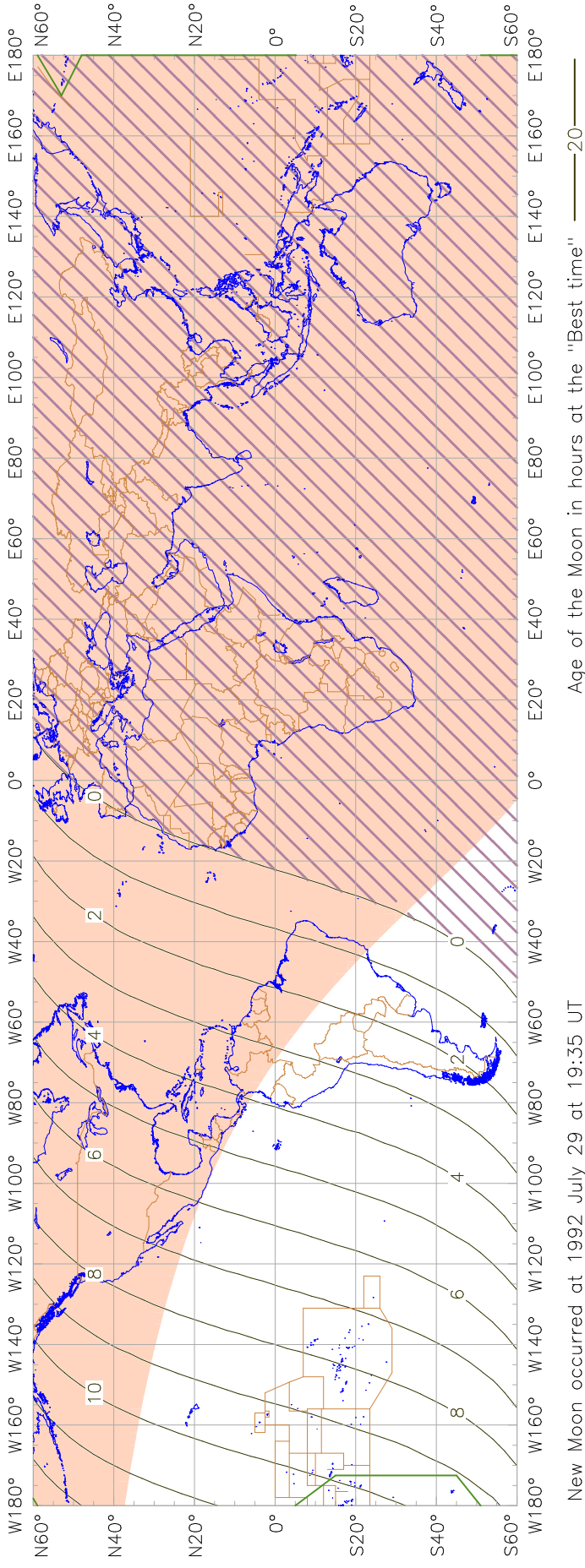


Visibility of the New Crescent Moon for 1992 July 29 (Safar 1413 AH)
