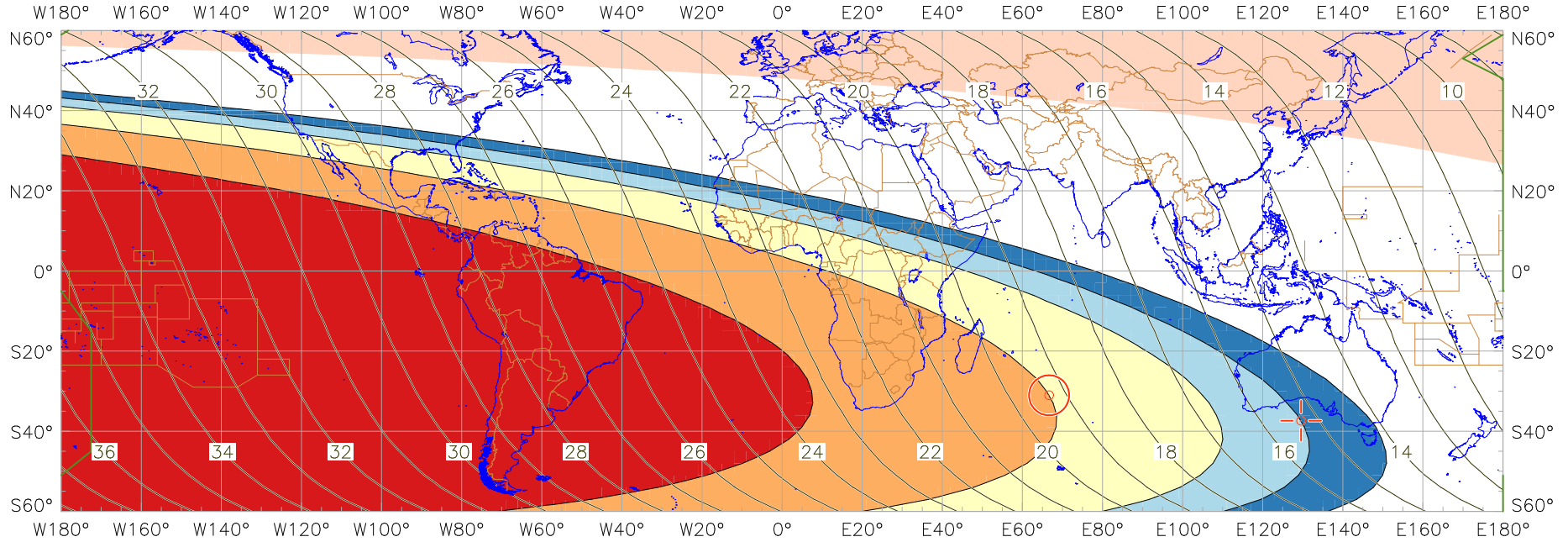


Visibility of the New Crescent Moon for 2009 November 17 (Dhu al-Hijja 1430 AH)



New Moon occurred at 2009 November 16 at 19:14 UT

Age of the Moon at first visibility with the naked eye = 19.30 hours

Age of the Moon in hours at the "Best time" ——— 20 ———

Age of the Moon at first visibility with a telescope = 15.30 hours

New Crescent Moon Visibility Key – Colour Coding of Shaded Areas
