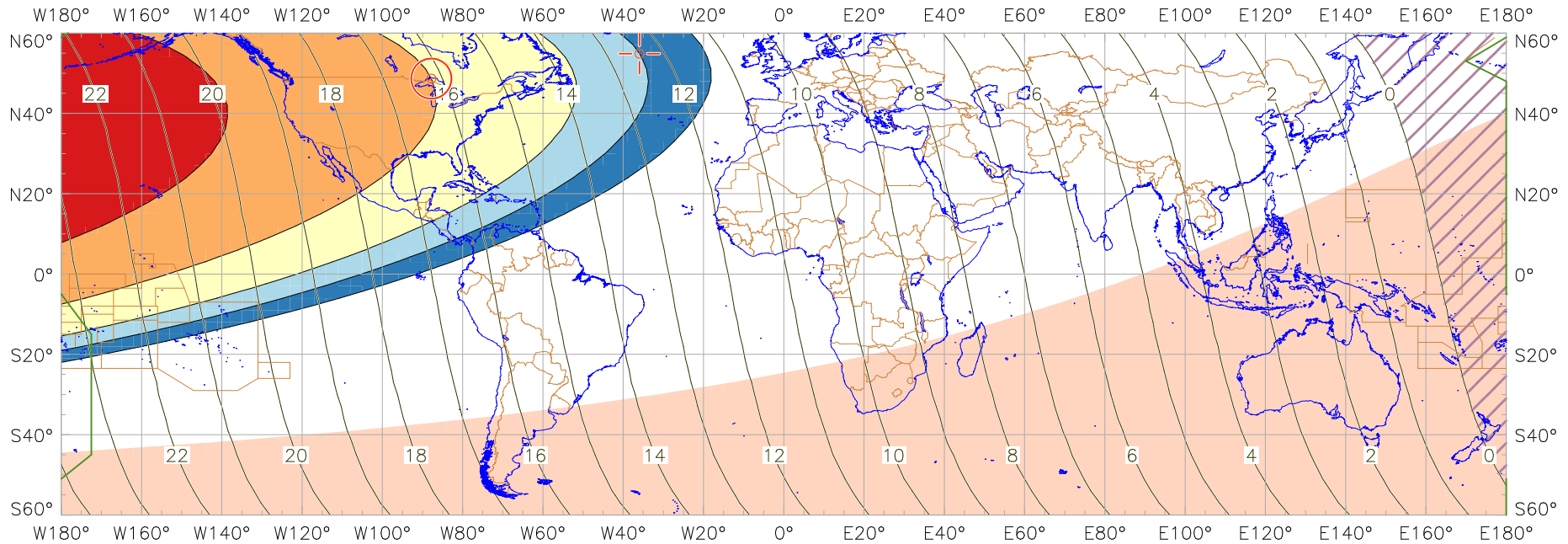


Visibility of the New Crescent Moon for 2013 February 10 (Rabi al-Ahir 1434 AH)



New Moon occurred at 2013 February 10 at 07:20 UT
 Age of the Moon at first visibility with the naked eye = 16.18 hours

Age of the Moon in hours at the "Best time" ——— 20 ———
 Age of the Moon at first visibility with a telescope = 12.42 hours

New Crescent Moon Visibility Key – Colour Coding of Shaded Areas
